CFMEU NSW PATTERN ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT BARGAINING UPDATE

As many Contractors are already aware, the CFMEU NSW has released its new 2024-2027 pattern Enterprise Agreement (**the Agreement**).

Master Builders has reviewed the Agreement and conducted several meetings with Members as well as a live webinar concerning the Agreement. Members can view the webinar by [clicking on this link](#) and can also see the slides for the webinar at [this link](#).

Master Builders' view is that the proposed new pattern Agreement should not be signed by contractors on the grounds that it cedes far too much control of the company to the CFMEU NSW. **Members that believe they are experiencing any form of coercion, undue influence or pressure to sign the Agreement may contact MBA NSW for assistance.**

Master Builders notes reports that the Victorian branch of the CFMEU has finalised its pattern Agreement and it has been confirmed that the Victorian Agreement does not contain the Security of Employment Clause (Clause 24 in the NSW pattern Agreement).

Master Builders NSW strongly urges Members not to sign the Agreement in its current form.
